AMOUNT AWARDED:

ONE OF EACH YEARLY*

Australia:

This scholarship is valued at \$13,000 this includes 65 days training with ADC and equipment.
The applicants must be Australian Citizens or Australian Permanent resident.

International:

This scholarship is valued at \$13,000 this includes 65 days training with ADC and equipment.
The applicants must be able to gain a study/student or visitor's visa.

ELIGIBILITY:

- ✓ Applicants should have a particular interest in the dog industry. Experience/background in dogs (showing, obedience, handling, boarding, working) would be an advantage.
- ✓ Applicants must be at least 17 years of age, have a genuine concern and affection for animals.
- ✓ Applicants must understand that dog grooming is a physically demanding career. They must be physical or otherwise fit so nothing prevents use of knowledge or skills gained from the training or successful job performance after completion of the training.

SELECTION:

When evaluating the applicants, an independent selection committee will consider the applicants background, financial need, community involvement, volunteer and/or business experience, essay, and letter of reference.

Three finalists will be presented to the directors of ADC and the awards will be chosen.

APPLICATION GUIDE:

The applicants must fill out the application form.
